Under 12's State Winter Championships

Geelong, Ringwood-Diamond Valley, Bendigo, City West, Dandenong, Latrobe Valley and home-town heroes Sunraysia will compete for the State Winter Championship.

Junior clinics in Mildura

Between back to back winter championships, the Baseball Victoria office has been in Mildura all week delivering a community engagement program across schools and community centres in the region as part of a dedicated regional strategy.

On Thursday staff headed to the Mildura Baseball Fields to run a series of clinics for the young baseball players of Mildura.

Matt Whyte, BV's School Sports Co-ordinator led the sessions, assisted by Jeff Paull, Taylor Crotty and Kelsey Quinn. Over 100 kids joined in with the activities, with ages ranging from 5 - 16. There were so many in fact that the participants had to be spit up into 3 groups; 2 for under 11's and 1 for the older children.

Information night in Mildura

Baseball Victoria ran an information night with Mildura baseball club representatives to help better address the needs of its regional members. Sunraysia Baseball League members were invited to attend and ask any questions of Baseball Victoria and to discuss how better BV can help one of its more regional association succeed.

Umpires Co-ordinator, Stewart Howe held an umpiring workshop with members of the Mildura baseball community in order to help improve the relationship between players and umpires. The workshop focused on a few key points; empowering players, parents and club members to call out bad spectator behaviour to make sure that umpires feel confident in their role, encouraging umpires, players and coaches to work any on-field concerns out in a co-operative, civil manner and to increase the number of younger umpires that get involved so as to foster a greater respect for the umpiring profession.
