The BV Development Grants Program is the product of a dedicated effort to revolutionize our approach to outreach and education. This new funding scheme provides grants ranging from \$500 to \$5000 to BV member clubs and associations across summer, winter and charters. Clubs and associations are strongly encouraged to take advantage of this opportunity, which is the latest effort in our proven history of driving participation and growth in baseball across Victoria.
