Coaching Clinic for Kids with Autism

We would like to thank the BV community for their great response and support of our upcoming Coaching Clinic for Autism Spectrum Disorder. Along with Scope Australia and the Department of Sport and Recreation Victoria, we will be presenting this coaching clinic next Wednesday, November 28th at Melbourne Baseball Club, and we would love to see our dedicated coaches and volunteers on the night. Coaches of all levels will receive valuable insight, advice and knowledge that will allow them to help children with autism succeed on and off the field. We strongly encourage any current or aspiring junior coaches to attend this clinic to get a better understanding of how to approach these awesome athletes who want to play but may need some additional support and guidance.

The clinic will run from 6:30 PM to 8:00 PM and will open with an introduction from BV. Then Scope staff will lead a session on Autism & Sport, followed by NCAS Coordinator Greg Tinkler who will explain how these ideas can be applied to coaching baseball. The clinic will wrap up with a fantastic interactive session that will show first-hand how to modify games for those affected by ASD. We hope many of our committed coaches take advantage of this opportunity to learn and grow as leaders in the baseball community and our inclusion initiatives.
