2019 Australian Women's Championships

Congratulations to our Youth Women's and Women's State Teams on their amazing accomplishments at the 2019 Australian Women's Baseball Championships in Canberra. It was truly wonderful to see so many of our awesome female athletes make the most of this opportunity. Victoria Blue capped off a dominant undefeated run with an 11-1 victory over Western Australia in the Gold Medal game. Victoria White finished in fifth place and Victoria Youth Women took home bronze medals.

Our Victorian representatives also claimed three of four Open Women's individual accolades on offer. Abbey Kelly was named Open Women's Most Valuable Player after playing a key role in Victoria Blue going undefeated on its way to the gold medal. Kelly hit .500 (15-for-30) across nine games in Blue's batting lineup and finished with a tidy ERA of 1.40 after throwing five innings on Day 1 of the event. Teammate Morgan Doty received the pitching award after not giving up a run in 9 1/3 innings. Doty struck out 10 hitters and allowed just three hits without a walk (one hit by pitch). Abbey McLellan earned the Batting Award after hitting .556 with a slugging percentage of .815. McLellan drove in a tournamenthigh 19 runs in 10 appearances.

Well done to all of our players, coaches and teams that worked so hard and showed their teamwork, positivity and determination on and off the field over the course of the 2019 Australian Women's Championships. We are so proud of their efforts and we look forward to seeing what these athletes can achieve in the years to come. This new funding scheme provides grants ranging from \$500 to \$5000 to BV member clubs and associations across summer, winter and charters.
