Registration of Non-Playing Members

We would greatly appreciate your support in encouraging non-playing members to register in the BV/SportsTG system. In addition to the players that take to the field every week, we also want to see more volunteers, parents and supporters registered in the SportsTG system. This way, not only can clubs more effectively communicate with all their members, but this will also allow for more accurate data on the number of people participating in baseball. This is crucial to receive government funding. At the last Australian Sports commission review, baseball was downgraded as a sport and funding was reduced. We can prevent this from happening in the future and in fact increase our access to funding by registering as many playing, non-playing and club volunteer members as possible.

We want to see increased government support and funding for our sport, and our clubs and members can play a critical role in this. As we open up summer registrations, please ensure all your playing

members, including seniors, juniors and T-ballers, are registered, and ask all non-playing members to register too, no matter how small their involvement may be. Registration categories include player, coach, umpire, scorer, official and volunteer. You can select more than one, but only a player member type has fees attached. There is no BA or BV fee to register as a non-playing member.

We thank you for your help and cooperation as we look to secure a brighter future for our sport across Victoria and Australia as a whole. If you have any questions about registering members, please contact Taylor Crotty in the BV Office.
