Baseball Victoria Development Grants Program

Applications for the Baseball Victoria Development Grants program closed on Sunday night, and we are so pleased with the response! We appreciate everyone's interest and those who took the time to submit an application. We received 24 applications from our enthusiastic clubs, associations and charters, and we are looking forward to reviewing these proposals for outreach activities. We plan on announcing successful applicants on Monday, October 15th. Our team is confident that this funding pathway will lead to a bigger and brighter future for baseball in our state, thanks to the collaborative efforts of our dedicated member clubs and associations.

P&S Meeting

We had a very productive and successful presidents and secretaries meeting on Monday night. Thank you to all members who came and participated in our important discussions to improve current and future competitions. Please note that there have been several changes regarding the melee rule and the minimum number of teams required for women's division 2. The rule regarding relegation from division 1 has been rewritten for clarity, and the rule regarding player eligibility for two teams in the same competition from the same club will undergo further analysis by the Pennant Committee. Rule changes will be updated on the website shortly, and a document with these changes will be sent via email for clubs to add to their rulebooks.
