LIQUOR POLICY

Baseball Victoria being recognised as the governing body of baseball in Victoria are responsible for the conduct of the sport of baseball in Victoria.

This policy has been developed and adopted to ensure that the provision of a safe and socially acceptable environment is provided and maintained for all those who administer, play, officiate, support or have some involvement in the sport in Victoria.

Responsibilities

1. Association

- Arrange for staff to be trained
- Provide literature/posters for club rooms
- Promote the provisions of the policy to clubs/members
- Advise clubs of changes to legislation as they occur

2. Club

- Have the appropriate license current at all time when alcohol is served or sold at the club
- Alcohol to be served in accordance with the provisions and in accordance with the State and Local Government Legislation and by laws and requirements
- Underage drinking is illegal and will not be permitted
- Ensue all those who serve alcohol is trained and aware of the current requirements and legislation from time to time
- Be aware of their responsibilities to those members, guests that alcohol is served in the correct manner.
- Who is responsible in the club for the policing of the policy
- Is there and what is the penalty for disobeying the rules and policy
- Healthy food options to supplement alcohol
- · Low alcohol at price substantially lower than heavy beer
- No prizes of alcohol
- Penalties for breach

3. Members

- Assist other members in transporting
- Any person not obeying the rules or acting in a manner unacceptable to the club to be brought to the notice of the club committee or person in charge
