2020/21 VSBL Season – COVID Rules, Score Entry and Fixture Updates

Baseball Victoria is excited for opening weekend of the 2020/21 VSBL season. After months of planning and preparation, it will be great to welcome so many players and teams to the field for the start of a big summer of baseball.

Please note we have finalised the <u>VSBL Playing Conditions</u> for the 2020/21 VSBL season with COVID rule updates, and these updated rules apply only to this upcoming season. These changes have been made to comply with the <u>Baseball Victoria Return to Play Plan</u> and Victorian Government guidelines.

"Participant safety remains our top priority heading into this summer season, and the VSBL Playing Conditions have been modified where necessary to ensure we can have a COVIDsafe competition for all players and officials," Baseball Victoria CEO Kristie Middleton said. "We look forward to a safe and successful season for Victorians of all ages and skill levels."

Baseball Victoria has also streamlined the process for entering scores for the 2020/21 VSBL season. In place of phoning in scores, clubs will be required to enter scores via SurveyMonkey, and match sheets may be submitted via SurveyMonkey or email. VSBL Return to Play Registration Reminder

As the 2020/21 VSBL season gets underway, we wish to remind our members that all players must be registered to play before participating in any games to comply with Victorian Government and Baseball Victoria COVIDSafe guidelines, found in our Return to Play Plan HERE.

If they haven't done so already, players who registered for the free return to training may now finalise their return to play registration by clicking <u>HERE</u>.

Players who have not yet registered to return to training and would like to do so before committing to play this season may register <u>HERE</u>.

Fees for Baseball Victoria and Baseball Australia are frozen at the same rates as last summer and the senior team fees are reduced by 50% with the junior team fees completely removed – junior teams are free for 2020/21. These significant reductions have allowed clubs to determine their fees with these reduced costs and pass those onto players as part of their overall club fees. Exact club fees have been determined by clubs and may appear online as part of clubs' SportsTG registration.
