#### **Baseball Victoria COVID-19 Update**

Following the easing of the statewide lockdown earlier this week, the Victorian Government outlined this Table of Restrictions from 11:59pm on Tuesday 27 July 2021, which includes:

- No visitors to homes
- Community sport can resume
- Masks remain mandatory indoors and outdoors
- Hospitality, retail, and gyms can reopen with a density limit of 1 person for every 4 square metres

The resumption of community sport includes a return to training and competition for all ages, limited to the minimum number of people required to participate in and facilitate the activity (i.e. players, coaches). Spectators are not allowed, excluding people necessary for events such as coaches, umpires, carers, parents and guardians.

## **Under 16 State Winter Championships**

Baseball Victoria is looking forward to the Under 16 State Winter Championships in Sale this weekend. The event, set for Saturday 31 July and 1 August 2021, will include less than 300 participants, which is the limit for outdoor activity. There will be no spectators in line with government restrictions.
