



Baseball Victoria 2021/22 COVID-19 COORDINATOR

A COVID-19 Coordinator will be appointed at each club to ensure all COVID protocols are undertaken and maintained.

The COVID-19 Coordinator will ensure the following is completed:

1. **QR Code:** Service Victoria QR Code prominently displayed at entrances, exits, dugouts and all traffic areas. Service Victoria QR code registration is [HERE](#).

2. **Nominate COVID Marshals for each training or game held at your club:** A COVID Check-in Marshal is a person responsible for ensuring each person who enters a venue uses the **Service Victoria QR code** to check in on arrival (or an alternative record keeping method, where relevant).

3. **Recording participants:** each person who enters a venue uses the Service Victoria QR code to check in on arrival (or an alternative record keeping method, where relevant).

4. **Registration:** participants are registered with SportsTG. This includes:

- Training attendees
- Coaches involved in training sessions
- Club committee members and volunteers attending the club

5. **COVID-19 signage:** signage from the 2020/21 season is still displayed. Printable signage can be found [HERE](#).

6. **Hygiene:**

- Ensure that the club has available hand sanitiser
- Ensure that the club has the provision to wipe down and sanitise hard surfaces
- Ensure that the club has the provisions to wipe down and sanitise any equipment
