## AUSTRALIAN WOMEN'S CHAMPIONSHIP COACH INFORMATION

The Australian Women's Championship (AWC) is the national tournament for female participants from all over Australia.

Baseball Victoria (BV) is now accepting applications for head coaches, assistant coaches, and executive officer positions for the 2022 Australian Women's Championship.

### CHAMPIONSHIPS

The tournament is scheduled to take place over the Easter holidays in West Beach, Adelaide. The venue and dates are yet to be confirmed by Baseball Australia. Traditionally the tournament runs for 8 days.

BV anticipates sending one team to the 2022 AWC.

### REQUIREMENTS

Appointed coaches will be required to assist with coordinating, implementing, and attending trials, training sessions, and other events as directed by Baseball Victoria.

Coaches will be responsible for coordinating their tryout days and team selections.

Each team's staff will consist of a head coach, 2 x assistant coaches, and 1 executive officer.

All participants are required to follow government COVID-19 vaccination regulations for Victoria and the host state. Attendees at Melbourne Ballpark aged 16 and over are required to be fully vaccinated to attend tryouts and training events.

Baseball Victoria is committed to protecting children from harm. All coaches are required to have current coaching accreditation. All coaches and executive officers are required to have a current Working with Children Check if team members are under 18 years of age.

BV require all applicants that will work with children to undergo an extensive screening process prior to appointment.
