# **Baseball Victoria COVID-19 Update**

Baseball Victoria is continuing to plan for the resumption of community sport and based on Victoria's Roadmap and further updates from the Victorian Government, we are expecting to start the 2021/22 VSBL season on Saturday 13 November 2021.

This date is subject to change depending on Victorian Government restrictions and how soon the state reaches its vaccination targets that will allow for a return to training and competition.

"We are excited to announce our anticipated start date for the 2021/22 VSBL season, and we are looking forward to an awesome summer of baseball," Baseball Victoria Interim CEO Gemma Scales said. "While this starting date is subject to Victoria reaching the required vaccination levels to return to community sport, based on the government's projections, we are confident we will be able to get the season underway later this year."

Baseball Victoria consulted with the BV Board, VSBL clubs, and Sport & Recreation Victoria regarding this expected start date to ensure we planned for an appropriate amount of time between the return to training and return to play.

We also have a plan in place in case we do not reach our targets on time and the start date needs to be pushed back.

This week, Victoria reached its first vaccination target of 80 percent one dose, allowing us to move forward with our 13 November start date plan.

Here are the key roadmap milestones and dates in our current plans, which will be used to confirm the VSBL season schedule in the coming weeks.

- 26-29 October 70% of eligible Victorians fully vaccinated
  - o Yes: return to training commences with 13 November start date
  - o No: shift to 4 December start date with a delayed return to training
- 5 November 80% of eligible Victorians fully vaccinated
  - Yes: proceed with 13 November start date
  - No: training may commence with 4 December start date, or if there is still no training, push back to a January VSBL start

We're looking forward to completing this director recruitment process so we can continue making progress on our updated strategic plan with a new CEO and President who will lead grassroots baseball into the next chapter of success."

The openings for Baseball Victoria Directors are voluntary leadership positions, well-suited for candidates with demonstrated board or senior executive experience, as well as a comprehensive understanding of corporate governance and a willingness to provide mentorship and strategic direction.

# **USA Coaching Accreditation**

As a reminder, USA Coaching Accreditation is available online, so anyone wanting to coach this summer can complete their coaching accreditation ahead of the season. The USA Baseball Coaches Certification Program offered through Baseball Australia consists of three certification levels (A, B, and C). Certification A and B are free with Certification C requiring a cost recovery for the practical assessment.

## **Government Funding for Sporting Clubs**

The Victorian Government is boosting support for thousands of sports clubs, leagues, and associations affected by public health restrictions to curb the spread of coronavirus. Applications are open for the \$10 million fourth round of the *Community Sport Sector COVID-19 Survival Package*, which to date has provided a lifeline for more than 6,300 clubs, with a further 430 leagues and associations and 75 state sporting associations, organisations, and regional academies also supported.

All Victorian clubs that have suffered losses due to the current lockdown will be eligible to apply, including clubs that have been awarded grants in earlier rounds of the program.

In the fourth round, clubs can apply for a grant of \$1,500 and local leagues and associations \$2,500 to cover costs and lost revenue associated with the cancellation of training, development programs and competition.

Previous recipients will be asked to respond to an email from Sport and Recreation Victoria by 29 October 2021 to receive their top-up grant.
