2021/22 VSBL Season Fixtures & Registration Now Live

Baseball Victoria is excited to share the 2021/22 VSBL season fixtures are now live as we look forward to our highly-anticipated return to play next month.

After the challenges of an extended lockdown, followed by our safe return to training upon hitting Victoria's vaccination targets, the Victorian baseball community will officially return to play on the weekend of 13-14 November for the start of the 2021/22 VSBL season.

Geelong Baycats charter competitions will start next week on Wednesday 3 November 2021 following the earlier return to training in regional Victoria.

Victorian Premier Daniel Andrews confirmed the return to community sport competition after reaching the 80 percent double dose vaccination target. Baseball Victoria is awaiting further clarifications from the government on the updated COVIDSafe settings and directions before finalising our Baseball Victoria Return to Play COVIDSafe Plan.

Get Active Kids Voucher Program

The Victorian Government is helping Victorian kids get outside and be active with applications now open for the third round of the \$21 million Get Active Kids Voucher Program. To be eligible, children must be Victorian residents, aged 18 and under, and named on a valid health care card or pensioner concession card, as well as a Medicare card.

Applications in Round 3 of the program close at 5pm on Tuesday 30 November 2021, and expenditure can be backdated to 1 January 2021 to cover sporting memberships, registration fees, uniforms and equipment. Click HERE to learn more and apply today.
