Baseball Victoria COVID-19 Update

Baseball Victoria continues to plan for the resumption of community sport and we are expecting to start the 2021/22 VSBL season on Saturday 13 November 2021. This date is based on Victoria's Roadmap and subject to change depending on Victorian Government restrictions and how soon the state reaches its vaccination targets that will allow for a return to training and competition.

As Victoria makes progress toward vaccination targets, here's a reminder of the key roadmap milestones and dates in our current plans, which will be used to confirm the VSBL season schedule in the coming weeks.

- 26-29 October 70% of eligible Victorians fully vaccinated
 - **Yes:** return to training commences with 13 November start date
 - No: shift to 4 December start date with a delayed return to training
- 5 November 80% of eligible Victorians fully vaccinated
 - **Yes:** proceed with 13 November start date
 - **No:** training may commence with 4 December start date, or if there is still no training, push back to a January VSBL start

Government Funding for Sporting Clubs

Applications are open for the \$10 million fourth round of the *Community Sport Sector COVID-19 Survival Package*. In the fourth round, clubs can apply for a grant of \$1,500 and local leagues and associations \$2,500 to cover costs and lost revenue associated with the cancellation of training, development programs and competition.

Get Active Kids Voucher Program

The Victorian Government is helping Victorian kids get outside and be active with applications now open for the third round of the \$21 million Get Active Kids Voucher Program. To be eligible, children must be Victorian residents, aged 18 and under, and named on a valid health care card or pensioner concession card, as well as a Medicare card.

Applications in Round 3 of the program close at 5pm on Tuesday 30 November 2021, and expenditure can be backdated to 1 January 2021 to cover sporting memberships, registration fees, uniforms and equipment. Click HERE to learn more and apply today.
