



Baseball Victoria CODE OF CONDUCT SPECTATORS

To ensure that all spectators are able to equally enjoy any Baseball Victoria sanctioned matches in a safe and secure environment, it is a condition of entry to venues that each person **MUST**:

1. RESPECT the decisions of match officials without abuse or recourse.
2. NOT engage in any form of harassment or abuse, including the use of obscene or offensive language or gestures so as to incite hatred or violence or partake in any indecent, racist chanting or anti-social behaviour.
3. RESPECT the rights of every person present regardless of their beliefs or background.
4. NOT encourage, NOT incite and NOT participate in any form of violence towards any person present.
5. RESPECT all duly appointed ground and club officials, coaches and players without abuse or recourse.
6. ACCEPT all other terms and conditions of entry to a public venue.
7. NOT throw any item whatsoever onto the field of play or at other spectators, officials or people.
8. NOT enter the field of play until advised to do so.
10. BEHAVE in a socially acceptable and responsible manner that enhances the reputation and goodwill of Baseball Victoria and the community.
11. NOT bring any alcohol, illegal substance, or drugs whatsoever into the venue.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Any person who does not comply with any part of this Code of Conduct or who otherwise causes a disturbance will:

- (1) be reported to the relevant authority,
- (2) will be evicted from the venue, and
- (3) may be banned from attending any or all future Baseball Victoria sanctioned matches.
