"The women's program is also benefiting from being immersed in the Baseball Victoria High Performance Program headed by Damian Shanahan and Keli'i Zablan. During these sessions, the players are being exposed to new and exciting theories and learnings which they are embracing head-on."

# **Get Active Kids Vouchers Program Update**

As a reminder, the Victorian Government's Get Active Kids Voucher Program is transitioning from a reimbursement model to a traditional voucher model, with voucher applications opening on Monday 21 March. This change will make it easier for eligible families to access local sport with reduced upfront registration and membership costs.

Victorian baseball clubs are encouraged to register to become a Get Active Kids Activity Provider and help kids get involved in sport and active recreation. Registered clubs will be able to accept vouchers of up to \$200 to support families facing financial barriers to participation.
