Essendon Baseball Club Welcomes Progress on Chris Lane Memorial Field

After several months of construction, Essendon Baseball Club is pleased to see progress on the Chris Lane Memorial Field. The project is dedicated in memory of local baseballer Chris Lane, who tragically passed away in August 2013. The field has been nearly a decade in the making, and Moonee Valley City Council recently committed additional funding to ensure the memorial is finished to high standards.

EBC President Tony Cornish says the council and community support has made a huge difference throughout this process.

"It would not have happened without them," Cornish said. "Construction has been slow due to rain, but we did gain more funding to give the field its bells and whistles. We are hoping it will be finished by the end of March with an opening probably at the start of next season."
