# Coaching Expressions of Interest For 2023 Australian Youth Women's Championship

Baseball Victoria has opened coaching applications for the 2023 Australian Youth Women's Championship, which will take place next April over the Easter holidays.

The Victorian Youth Women's State Team will need a head coach, two assistant coaches, and an executive officer. This is an exciting opportunity to lead the youth women's team in the first AYWC since 2019.

All coaches are required to have current coaching accreditation. Coaches must assist with coordinating, implementing, and attending trials, training sessions, and other events as directed by Baseball Victoria. Coaches will be responsible for coordinating tryout days and team selections.

Please note all coaches and executive officers are required to have a current Working with Children Check. Position descriptions for coaches and officials can be found <u>HERE</u>.

## **Fair Play Code**

We would like to remind all baseball clubs and members of the Victorian Government's 2022 Fair Play Code, an update of the 2018 blueprint that sets out the standards of behaviour expected of everyone involved in sport and active recreation. Sporting organisations that receive funding from the Victorian Government must actively promote, adhere to, and enforce the Fair Play Code. This includes Baseball Victoria and our member clubs.

At the heart of the Fair Play Code are the five principles:

- Integrity
- Respect
- Responsibility
- Safety
- Fairness

The Fair Play Code is a guide on how to apply the principles and the responsibilities of those involved in sport. These principles apply to everyone, no matter what role they play. Positive and appropriate actions and behaviours of each and every one of these individuals are essential to ensuring safe, fair, and inclusive sporting environments.

There is no place in sport for bad behaviour, violence, cheating or intimidation. As an individual, team, club, league or association, if you encounter bad behaviour, either on or off the sporting field, refer to the Fair Play Code.
