The 2023 U16 & U18 Australian Youth Championships are in full swing at Blacktown International Sportspark, with our Victorian teams making the most of an amazing opportunity to represent on the national stage.

Our players joined their peers from around the country in a pre-tournament showcase before games began on Thursday. In the U16 competition, Victoria put up a great effort but fell just short, finishing 6-4 behind South Australia. It was a close battle in the U18s too, with Victoria holding on for a 5-3 victory over SA.

The U16s picked up their first win on Friday with a 9-5 result over NSW Country, while the U18s recorded a 14-0 victory, collecting 13 hits and giving up just three.

Fair Play Code

As we head back into summer baseball, we would like to remind all baseball clubs and members of the Victorian Government's 2022 <u>Fair Play Code</u>. This is an update of the 2018 blueprint that sets out the standards of behaviour expected of everyone involved in sport and active recreation. Sporting organisations that receive funding from the Victorian Government must actively promote, adhere to, and enforce the Fair Play Code. This includes Baseball Victoria and our member clubs.

At the heart of the Fair Play Code are the five principles:

- Integrity
- Respect
- Responsibility
- Safety
- Fairness

The Fair Play Code is a guide on how to apply the principles and the responsibilities of those involved in sport. These principles apply to everyone, no matter what role they play. Positive and appropriate actions and behaviours of each and every one of these individuals are essential to ensuring safe, fair, and inclusive sporting environments.

There is no place in sport for bad behaviour, violence, cheating or intimidation. As an individual, team, club, league or association, if you encounter bad behaviour, either on or off the sporting field, refer to the Fair Play Code.

<u>Futures U12/U14 East and West</u> tryouts are coming up! As part of our new Performance Pathway (PP), the 2023 Futures tier will include U12 and U14 players who are top performers for their age group at the club, Little League, and Junior League levels.

This tier is open to U12 players (born 2011 and 2012) and U14 players (born 2009 and 2010). The Futures pathway is a step beyond the existing charter program and offers high-performing players the chance to further develop their skills and pursue representative opportunities.
