It's National Volunteer Week, and we would like to thank all the amazing volunteers who support baseball in Victoria.


We have over 500 registered volunteers who dedicate so much time and energy to ensuring our grassroots sport is a fun and safe environment for all.

The NCAA Division I Council has approved recruiting rule changes, which will eliminate communication between college coaches and players until 1 August of Year 11. Under the new rules, no unofficial or official campus visits or off-campus contacts can take place prior to 1 September of Year 11.
