The camp is set for late September and will see 40 players from across the country enter into the Australian Institute of Sport (AIS) in Canberra, completing the National Junior Program's recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic.

Players were selected based on performances at the 2023 Australian Youth Championships this past January.

Women & Girls Development Scores Big With Experienced Coaches, New Opportunities


Samantha Hamilton has been appointed as BV Performance Pathway Coach as part of our ongoing commitment to women's baseball development.
