"With dedicated coaching staff and support from across the state and around the country, we know our youth women's players will continue to develop their skills and thrive in the sport they love."


The Barclay Cup program and trials will be conducted and organised by the BV Performance Pathway team, with Alan Sutherland and Sophia Stensholt confirmed as team head coaches.

Trials will take place on Friday 21 July (and 28 July if required) from 6-8:30pm at Melbourne Ballpark. All female players who will be aged 13 to 16 by 31 August 2023 are eligible to participate.

The price of attending the tournament is approximately \$2,500 per player. This price will include a uniform package for the players, flights, accommodation, meals, ground transport, tournament entry fee, and more. 
