Although Australia missed out the Super Round after some close losses, they are in the running for world ranking points, which will determine who qualifies for the 2024 Premier-12 tournament.

Four Victorians are on the roster: catcher Declan Speirs and infielders Jack Ratcliffe, Jayden Kim, and Lachlan Smith. BV High Performance Officer Damian Shanahan is the team's assistant coach.

## Australia Gears up for the Asia Professional Baseball Championships in Tokyo

In more Australian baseball news, Team Australia will return to the famous Tokyo Dome in November to take on some of the world's best in the Asia Professional Baseball Championship (APBC).

The championship pits the best Under-24 players from the Nippon Professional Baseball (NPB, Japan), Korean Baseball Organization (KBO, South Korea), Chinese Professional Baseball League (CPBL, Taiwan) and Australian Baseball League (ABL) against each other. The tournament will be played from 16-19 November.

### **Tryout Registration Open for 2024 Australian Youth Championships**

Baseball Victoria is pleased to open tryout registration for Victorian State Teams ahead of the 2024 Australian U16 and U18 Youth Championships next January. We will be sending one U16 and one U18 team to the national championships, with dates and venue TBA by Baseball Australia.

Tryouts will be held on the following dates:

- U16: Saturday 7, 14, 21 October and 28 October (if required)
- U18: Monday 9, 16 October (positional players), Tuesday 10, 17 (pitchers/catchers), 24 October (all players)

Tryout venue: Melbourne Ballpark, Merton Street, Altona Meadows Times: TBC

#### BV Performance Pathway: 2023 Youth Women's Prospects Tryout Registration

Tryout registration is also open for the Youth Women's Prospects Program as part of the new BV Performance Pathway. The Youth Women's Prospects Pathway is a step beyond the existing club program and offers high-performing players the chance to further develop their skills and pursue representative opportunities.

A tryout will take place on Saturday 14 October for players born between 2003 and 2008 who are the top performers in their club. Tryouts and training will be at Newport Baseball Club from 8:30am-11am.

The program will be run over seven weeks under the leadership of both Samantha Hamilton (Victorian Women's Head Coach) and Dean Anglin (Victorian Youth Women's Head Coach).

"We're thrilled to announce the Youth Women's Prospects Program. Our main objective is to provide young female athletes with more opportunities to sharpen their skills," Hamilton elaborated. "Our dedication to reinforcing key aspects of their game and preparing them to compete at the next level is our focus."

"The potential within Victoria's emerging baseball talent is incredibly promising, and we're excited to be a part of their ongoing path to growth and achievement, both within the game and beyond. We're also committed to upskilling those coaches within the Baseball Victoria Coaching Panel, ensuring a holistic approach to player development."

The cost of the program will be approx. \$550, which includes quality coaching, Prospect playing cap, and training top.


