# Australia to Open 2024 WBSC Premier12 vs World #1 Japan

Australia's group in the 2024 Premier12 has been revealed.\_Australia will play in Group B with Japan, Korea, Chinese Taipei, Cuba and Dominican Republic from 14-18 November.

Australia will open Group B action with a game in Nagoya, Japan vs the World #1 Japanese side. The two teams will then fly to Taipei, Taiwan for the rest of the games.

Group A will be played in Mexico. The Group A teams are USA, Mexico, Netherlands, Panama, Puerto Rico and Venezuela.

After round-robin play, the top two finishers of each group will compete in the Super Round. The first and second-place teams of the Super Round will compete in the Premier12 Championship game, while the third and fourth-place finishers will play for a bronze medal.

# Club News: WWCC and Child Protection/Sports Integrity

If you have children at your club, whether it be for junior competitions or family events, please keep in mind the updated <u>Working with Children Check</u> and Child Protection/Sports Integrity guidelines.

All club volunteers, including committee members, coaches, umpires, scorers, groundskeepers, and canteen staff, must have a valid WWCC with a list regularly maintained by the club. We ask that all club committee members also complete the <u>11 Child Safe Sport Modules</u>.

#### Change Our Game Research on Importance of Representation in Community Sport

New research supported by the Office for Women in Sport and Recreation highlights the important influence women in coaching and officiating roles have on children.

Research by Victoria University found that increased representation and visibility of women in coaching and officiating roles in community sport can challenge attitudes and positively influence unconscious gender bias of children associating men in these roles.

#### The key findings revealed:

- previous experience with a woman as a coach positively influenced children's belief that women can be great coaches
- parental attitudes greatly influence their children's attitudes
- satisfaction levels of girls with having a woman as a coach and/or official was higher than for boys
