Belles Bring Home Little League Girls Silver Medal After Historic Tournament

After an amazing week at the world's first Little League Girls National Championship in Lismore, Victoria Belles are happily coming home with a silver medal.

Belles made it all the way to the gold medal game after going 4-1 in pool play. They played NSW Blue for the championship title, and although it wasn't their day on the scoreboard, their infectious spirit and determination never wavered.

The Belles took a leap in 2023 by entering an all-girls team into the Little League Division 2 National Championships. They helped inspire all states to come together and submit a team to the world's first all-girls national title.

After dropping their first game of the tournament, the Belles won four in a row and came from behind in two of the games. They also got to meet incredible role models on the Victoria Aces, Brisbane Bandits, and Adelaide Giants teams competing in the 2024 Australian Women's Baseball Showcase.
