BV Performance Pathway Eastern Training Centre

The new BV Performance Pathway Eastern Training Centre is up and running at Dandenong (Winter) and Mulgrave (Summer) Baseball Clubs. We held our first training session at Robert Booth Reserve (Clow Street, Dandenong) on Wednesday 15 May and will continue to hold Wednesday night sessions for our Prospects and Select programs running from May to September.

"We started investigating various club venues as possible training options for our Performance Pathway programs about 18 months ago. We completed a review on current club facilities and found Dandenong/Mulgrave to be the best option for training programs in the eastern suburbs," BV CEO Chet Gray said.

"Earlier this year, we met with both club presidents as well as representatives from the Greater Dandenong Council. We are excited to get this new training centre underway and we look forward to hosting various Performance Pathway programs over the next year."

Baseball Victoria has invested just over \$12,000 on various equipment for the centre. This includes the purchase of a batting turtle from Softball ACT, previously used in the build-up and during the 2000 Sydney Games, plus ground covers and lock-up toolboxes, etc.

Stay tuned for more updates as we continue to use the new Eastern Training Centre and assist both clubs and the Greater Dandenong Council with venue facility upgrades, such as batting tunnels and bullpens. We are also exploring other possible training centre options in the northern area.

Behind The Mask Community Umpiring Training at Brookdale Reserve, Point Cook

The BV Umpiring Working Group, in conjunction with Melbourne Winter Baseball League, continued the delivery of the Behind the Mask program for new umpires earlier this month. Umpire Operations Officer David Welsh, Development Officer Geoff Dunn, and Member Engagement Manager Alan Sutherland led the sessions at Point Cook Baseball and Softball Club.

The first session was theory, dedicated to umpiring general principles, safety, and common rules, followed by the second session with on-field training. This primarily focused on a single-person umpiring system, including calling balls and strikes from behind the pitcher, moving around the umpire working area, and calling safes and outs at the bases.

We had 11 umpires complete the theory and five continued on to complete the practical session. These new umpires were mums, dads, carers, and juniors from Sunshine, Footscray, Newport, and Port Melbourne Baseball Clubs.

Club News: WWCC and Child Protection/Sports Integrity

If you have children at your club, whether it be for junior competitions or family events, please keep in mind the updated <u>Working with Children Check</u> and Child Protection/Sports Integrity guidelines. All club volunteers, including committee members, coaches, umpires, scorers, groundskeepers, and canteen staff, must have a valid WWCC with a list regularly maintained by the club. We ask that all club committee members also complete the <u>11 Child Safe Sport Modules</u>.

Club News: New ATO Annual Reporting Changes

National and state sporting organisations and clubs must follow <u>new requirements</u> for annual reporting to continue accessing an income tax exemption.
