Sporting Club Grants Program

The Victorian Government is backing grassroots sports clubs to break down barriers to participation and help build social and active local communities through the Sporting Club Grants Program.

Grants are provided to clubs for uniforms and equipment that improve accessibility and engagement, projects that strengthen volunteering and officiating, new sport or recreation programs to inspire more people to get involved, and support for athlete travel to competitions.

The latest round is providing more than 400 grants to clubs all around Victoria, including Alfredton, Bellarine, Bonbeach, Heathmont, Malvern, Melbourne, Moorabbin, Morwell, Mulgrave, Ormond Glenhuntly, Pivot City, Scots, Springvale, Sunshine, University of Melbourne, and Waverley Baseball Clubs, as well as Geelong Baseball Association.
