



## SAMPLE OFFICIALS CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. Place the safety and welfare of the participants above all else.
- 2. Accept responsibility for all your actions.
- 3. Be impartial.
- 4. Avoid any situation which may lead to a conflict of interest.
- 5. Be courteous, respectful and open to discussion and interaction.
- 6. Verbal abuse towards players, managers, coaches, officials or spectators will not be tolerated.
- 7. Seek continual self-improvement through the study, performance appraisal and regular updating of competencies.
- 8. Develop respect for teams, managers, coaches and officials.
- 9. Be a positive role model in behaviour and personal appearance.
- 10. Keep yourself informed of sound umpiring principles and seek skilled advice when necessary.
