

Victorians Conor Myles, Ben Fierenzi, Zak Skinner, Chris Burke, and Damian Shanahan (assistant coach) were all part of the team, which came away with a 4-4 record vs eight different countries. They finished ninth in the World Cup to pick up a projected 207 World Ranking Points.


