Their experience includes a five-game series vs the United States 15U national team, training sessions and games at U.S junior colleges and universities plus a tournament at the prestigious Under 16 Perfect Game Fall World Series vs some of the best junior baseballers in America.

Blake Townsend Signs With Pittsburgh Pirates

Within three weeks of being released by the Seattle Mariners, Victorian Blake Townsend has a new professional organisation to call home. The Adelaide Giants and Australian national team pitcher agreed to a minor league deal with the Pittsburgh Pirates last month.

The 23-year-old from rural Victoria spent the last five seasons with the Mariners, reaching as high as Triple-A. He pitched for Australia at the 2023 World Baseball Classic and was originally named to the 2024 Under-23 World Cup roster, although he is no longer able to attend the tournament due to Minor League Baseball commitments.

Townsend was piecing together his best season as a pro in 2024. In 29.1 innings across 28 appearances in High-A, Townsend had a 2.45 ERA while limiting opponents to a .200 average.

Ten Australian baseball players have been invited to play on the World Select Team at the upcoming Major League Baseball College Showcase Tour in Arizona, including Victorians Jack Ratcliffe and Ryder Wilson.

The annual event welcomes amateur baseball players, all under age 20, from Europe, Asia, South America, North America and Australia, to Arizona. The showcase is an initiative that MLB has employed to grow the game internationally. This year's edition runs from 23 September to 3 October.

Players participate in an 11-day experience that includes visits to local Arizona colleges and universities, games against teams at various levels and a pro-style workout day for college recruiters and professional scouts.


Club News: WWCC and Child Protection/Sports Integrity
