After Big Year With Belles, Audrey Cheung Sets Her Sights on U12 World Cup Qualifier

11-year-old Audrey Cheung was part of the historic Australian Little League Girls Tournament, a world first, and now she's hoping to end the year on a high as part of the Team Australia U12 World Cup Qualifier.

Audrey was one of 18 players named to the Qualification Squad, joining fellow Victorians Harvey Ninnis and Phil Toye, as Australia's littlest national team heads to Guam to try to qualify for the 2025 U12 World Cup.

The Green and Gold will compete with Guam and Northern Mariana Islands in games starting 29 November and running through 2 December.

"It feels incredible to know that all my training and experience in this sport has helped me to become the player I am today and achieve this goal I have aspired to accomplish," Audrey said. "I am beyond grateful and excited for this opportunity to pursue this sport to such a high level and meet people from across the world."

Pipeline 2Ball + Coach Education




Tickets to the Aces game are free for participating players, officials, and immediate family, plus discounted \$5 tickets for other club members who come to watch. Dates are available through December and January.
