

#### Baseball Victoria Performance Pathway: 2025 Futures Program Tryouts

Baseball Victoria is pleased to announce the return of our Performance Pathway (PP) Futures U12/U14 East and West program. Tryouts will take place in late January for the Futures tier, which includes U12 and U14 players who are top performers for their age group at the club/charter level.

This Futures tier is open to U12 players (born 2013 and 2014) and U14 players (born 2011 and 2012). This pathway is a step beyond the existing charter program and offers high-performing players the chance to further develop their skills and pursue representative opportunities.

Tryout dates and locations:

- Futures U14 West Wednesday 15 January at Melbourne Ballpark
- Futures U14 East Friday 17 January at Moorabbin Baseball Club
- Futures U12 East Monday 20 January at Mulgrave Baseball Club
- Futures U12 West Tuesday 21 January at Melbourne Ballpark

Each tryout will run between approx. 5pm to 8:30pm and may be split into groups depending on the volume of attendees. A confirmation email with your allotted time slot will be provided closer to the date.

- Have completed and submitted the ASC Officiating modules

#### Club News: Dealing With The Moment – Anti-Racism in Community Sport

Sport Australia's free <u>Anti-Racism – Dealing With The Moment</u> course helps community coaches, umpires, participants and volunteers to deal with racism in the moment it occurs.

Across four modules and approximately one hour, users will learn about racism in community sport, practical and tangible actions to prevent racism, when to intervene and the importance of acting in the moment as well as the importance of listening to and respecting the victim.

#### Club News: AED Authority – Life-Saving Defibrillators

Cardiac arrests can occur unexpectedly, anywhere, anytime—even during a sports match and even in peak physical condition, as seen with Christian Eriksen. The Danish footballer, who plays at the top level for Denmark and Manchester United, suffered a sudden cardiac arrest in 2021, during a UEFA Euro match against Finland. Quick action with CPR and an AED saved his life, underscoring the critical importance of being prepared for such emergencies in sports settings.

Clubs are encouraged to tap into the <u>SRV Emergency Sporting Equipment Grant Program</u> to help fund this life-saving equipment. #### Club News: WWCC and Child Protection/Sports Integrity

If you have children at your club, whether it be for junior competitions or family events, please keep in mind the updated <u>Working with Children Check</u> and Child Protection/Sports Integrity guidelines. All club volunteers, including committee members, coaches, umpires, scorers, groundskeepers, and canteen staff, must have a valid WWCC with a list regularly maintained by the club. We ask that all club committee members also complete the <u>11 Child Safe Sport Modules</u>.
