


All-Female Umpiring Panel Announced for 2025 AWC & AYWC

In a historic first, the 2025 Australian Women's and Youth Women's Championships will feature an all-female panel. Congratulations to our very own Victorian umpires Janine Thompson and Jenelle Stafilis on their appointments.

From 13-19 April at Melbourne Ballpark, six open women's teams (16+) and five youth women's sides (U16) from across the country will compete for the title of national champions.

\$5 from the sale of each "Girls Are Players Too" t-shirt will be contributed directly to the teams. Shirts are available to players, coaches, team supporters, families, friends, and more. All you have to do is in your cart before you checkout, select which state and which team - Elite or Youth - you'd like the \$5 to go to!

The team with the most funds raised by 11 April will also receive a special prize pack including a hat, t-shirt, bag, shoe charm, and sticker pack. The funds raised for each team, and the winning team prize pack, will be presented in person by WBIP's own Amy McCann during the championships.

The "Girls Are Players Too" Fundraiser is accompanied by an exciting new <u>national podcast series</u>, hosted by Emeralds alumni Amy McCann, Tahnee Lovering, and Amy Cannington. Team Australia Announces Players on 2025 Under 16 Junior Squad

Team Australia has finalised selections for the <u>2025 Under 16 National Junior Squad</u>, with eight Victorians making the cut. A huge congratulations to Cooper Bishop-Worn, Cooper Busch, Euan Clarkin, Jarvis Johansen, Mitch Langworthy, Marcus Murphy, Brody Stokes, and Brodie Trevean, who were selected based off their performance at the 2025 Australian Youth Championships in January.

In total, 36 players from across the country will head to the United States in early July to play at the U16 WWBA Championships in Atlanta, Georgia in front of college coaches and MLB scouts. They will play in the tournament as two separate teams of 18, which will be announced closer to tournament time.
