Athletics Win 2025 Junior & Senior League State Championships


The 2025 Junior and Senior League (SL80 and SL90) State Championships wrapped up at Geelong Baseball Complex on Monday 7 April.

A record 330 nominations were received from the Victorian sporting community, honouring those who have made an exceptional contribution to sport and recreation in Victoria during the previous calendar year.




