Team Australia's Under 18 World Cup Schedule & Group Revealed

The World Baseball Softball Confederation (WBSC) announced the <u>official schedule</u> of the <u>WBSC U-18</u> <u>Baseball World Cup 2025 presented by RAXUS</u>, which will take place from 5 to 14 September in Naha City, Okinawa Prefecture, Japan.

After defeating New Zealand in a <u>best-of-five qualifying series</u> last December, Australia is in Group B with China, Germany, Panama, Chinese Taipei and the USA.
