The two-day conference focused on teaching coaches how to create engaging learning environments and explore modern trends of coaching and development.

Dr. Jeff Simons, a Professor of Kinesiology at California State University, East Bay, who specialises in the psychology of sport and physical activity, presented at the conference. The Australian Institute of Sport (AIS) was also in attendance.

This was a fantastic opportunity for coaching development and collaboration leading into the Under 18 World Cup Selection Camp.


Centre for Wellbeing Science (University of Melbourne) Performance Skills Inventory
