U16 National Squad Competing in Japan Next Month

Two Australian National Under 16 teams will head to Japan to compete in tournaments next month.

In March 2025, Team Australia <u>named 34 players to a national squad selected</u> off the backs of their performance at the Australian Youth Championships. The squad has since been split into one team of 18 and one team of 16 based off their date of births and school year.

One squad will compete at the 15U Perfect Game Pacific Baseball Championships in Sapporo, while the other will play against some of the top Japanese junior teams – including a double-header vs the Tokyo Giants U15 Team – in Tokyo.


