# **U16 National Squad Competing in Japan**

Australia's U16 National Squad has arrived in Fuchu, Japan. In March 2025, Team Australia <u>named 34</u> <u>players to a national squad selected</u> off the backs of their performance at the Australian Youth Championships. The squad has since been split into one team of 18 and one team of 16 based off their date of births and school year.

One squad will compete at the 15U Perfect Game Pacific Baseball Championships in Sapporo, while the other will play against some of the top Japanese junior teams – including a double-header vs the Tokyo Giants U15 Team – in Tokyo.

# Victorians Represent Team Australia at Under 12 World Cup

Victorians Harvey Ninnis, Phil Toye, and Jaxon Waters proudly wore the Green and Gold, representing Team Australia at the 2025 WBSC Under 12 Baseball World Cup in Chinese Taipei. Australia finished with their best-ever placing in the U12 event, finishing ninth overall. Their previous best was tenth.

As a result of the strong U12 performance, <u>Australia picked up 104 points</u>, improving their standing from 11<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> in the WBSC Men's Baseball World Rankings. It's the first time Australia has been in the top ten since October 2023 and edges our ranking above traditional baseball powerhouses like Dominican Republic (11th) and Cuba (12th).

## <u>Victorian Travis Finney Commits to NCAA Division I Program South Dakota State</u>

Victorian Travis Finney has committed to play top-level college baseball in the United States, announcing that he is joining South Dakota State University for the 2026 season.

In 2025, a record 2<u>4 Australians played</u> NCAA Division I baseball. Finney, a product of the Frankston Tomatoes and Moorabbin Panthers, is coming off a standout season with Yakima Valley College in Washington State while playing JUCO.

He won two Pacific Association Golden Glove Awards for his stellar work in the infield. Finney slashed .331/.455/.840 in 48 games this season with 20 RBI and eight stolen bases. He made just three errors in 3 in 361 opportunities in two seasons with the Yaks.


Congratulations to BV Performance Pathway alumni Ryan Othen and Nick Bertucci, who joined pitching coach John (Jay) O'Connor on the Foxes this season. They had the best record in the league going into semi-finals on Saturday, where they defeated the Pueblo Spradley Collegians to advance to the final.

They won the championship, coming back from six runs down to defeat the Western Nebraska Pioneers on Sunday, 12-10. The Foxes finished the season with a record of 32 wins against just 7 losses.

In Saturday's semi-final, Nick Bertucci homered and scored three times (2-for-3, 3R, 2RBI) while Ryan Othen closed out the win on the mound (2IP, 0H, 0R, 0BB, 3K).

On Sunday, Nick's 3-run home run (13th on the season) in the bottom of the 8th brought the Foxes within one run of the Pioneers and changed the momentum. He batted 2-for-3, 3R, 3BI on the day.
