Will Hardy Named to World Select Team for MLB College Showcase Tour in October

A huge congratulations to BV Performance Pathway athlete Will Hardy, who is one of 11 Australian baseball players invited to play on the 'MLB World Select Team' at the upcoming Major League Baseball College Showcase Tour in Arizona.

The annual event welcomes amateur baseball players, all under age 20, from Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brazil, Czech Republic, Curaçao, Germany, Netherlands, and Spain to Arizona.

There are 30 players on the trip total, and the showcase is an initiative that MLB has employed to grow the game internationally. This year's edition runs from 23 September to 2 October 2025.

Hardy is returning after a successful U18 World Cup where he played third base and shortstop for Australia and led off. The infielder collected five hits across his final two games and seemed to improve as the tournament went on.



Baseball Australia Confirms National Championship Dates and Locations for 2026

Baseball Australia has announced the location and dates of the 2026 National Australian Baseball Championships. Each year, BA runs ten national tournaments for varying age groups.


The Australian Youth Championships (U16 and U18) and the Australian Women's Championships serve has Performance Pathways Events and are used in evaluation for national team selection, as well as for professional and college scouts.

The Little League, Junior League, Intermediate League, and Senior League Tournaments serve as part of the Little League International Pathway, with automatic entry into a World Series event in the USA designated to the winner.

There are a few changes from the 2025 calendar year: the Australian Youth Championships (AYC) move from Sydney to three clubs in Melbourne. The Senior League titles move from Geelong to Sydney.

Further, an <u>expression of interest</u> is now available to host for 2027 National Championships. Clubs and state associations from across the country can apply. For more information, <u>click here</u>.

Tribunal members will hear appeal cases over player penalties and meet at most once a week. The number of cases varies each year depending on the games played and any player ejections during the competition. Tribunal cases have declined in recent years, marking a positive trend for our grassroots sport.

While we are seeking individuals with experience in tribunal and legal processes, this is not required when applying. If you are interested in this opportunity, please keep in mind that in order to be successful with your application, you must:

- Have a clear understanding of the rules and processes while adhering to the Victorian Summer Baseball League rules and regulations, Baseball Victoria By-Laws and the rules of baseball.
- Be reliable and prepared to attend hearings on a weekly basis.
- Hold a high level of confidentiality.
- Provide feedback and assist in any further review in conjunction with the VSBL Pennant Committee.

Victorian Baseball Scorers Inc. Annual General Meeting


