Tribunal Member Applications Open for 2025/26 VSBL Season

Baseball Victoria is looking for volunteers to serve on the VSBL Tribunal Panel for the 2025/26 VSBL season. The match review officer and tribunal members play a valuable role in ensuring a successful summer season and a fair and safe experience for all participants.

Tribunal members will hear appeal cases over player penalties and meet at most once a week. The number of cases varies each year depending on the games played and any player ejections during the competition. Tribunal cases have declined in recent years, marking a positive trend for our grassroots sport.

While we are seeking individuals with experience in tribunal and legal processes, this is not required when applying.

If you are interested in this opportunity, please keep in mind that in order to be successful with your application, you must:

- Have a clear understanding of the rules and processes while adhering to the Victorian Summer Baseball League rules and regulations, Baseball Victoria By-Laws and the rules of baseball.
- Be reliable and prepared to attend hearings on a weekly basis.
- Hold a high level of confidentiality.
- Provide feedback and assist in any further review in conjunction with the VSBL Pennant Committee.
