## Baseball Australia Confirms National Championship Dates and Locations for 2026

Baseball Australia has announced the location and dates of the 2026 National Australian Baseball Championships. Each year, BA runs ten national tournaments for varying age groups.









The Australian Youth Championships (U16 and U18) and the Australian Women's Championships serve as Performance Pathways Events and are used in evaluation for national team selection, as well as for professional and college scouts.

The Little League, Junior League, Intermediate League, and Senior League Tournaments serve as part of the Little League International Pathway, with automatic entry into a World Series event in the USA designated to the winner.

There are a few changes from the 2025 calendar year: the Australian Youth Championships (AYC) move from Sydney to three clubs in Melbourne. The Senior League titles move from Geelong to Sydney.

Further, an [expression of interest](#) is now available to host for 2027 National Championships. Clubs and state associations from across the country can apply. For more information, [click here](#).

Tribunal members will hear appeal cases over player penalties and meet at most once a week. The number of cases varies each year depending on the games played and any player ejections during the competition. Tribunal cases have declined in recent years, marking a positive trend for our grassroots sport.

While we are seeking individuals with experience in tribunal and legal processes, this is not required when applying.



If you are interested in this opportunity, please keep in mind that in order to be successful with your application, you must:

- Have a clear understanding of the rules and processes while adhering to the Victorian Summer Baseball League rules and regulations, Baseball Victoria By-Laws and the rules of baseball.
- Be reliable and prepared to attend hearings on a weekly basis.
- Hold a high level of confidentiality.
- Provide feedback and assist in any further review in conjunction with the VSBL Pennant Committee.

### **Club News: Churchill Braves Honour Two Club Stalwarts**

Churchill Baseball Club's Annual Presentation Night was one to remember, with two of its most loyal members recognised for a lifetime of service to the game and their community.

Tony Dickinson was elevated to Club Legend status — just the second in the club's 51-year history — while his wife Carol Dickinson was awarded Life Membership, joining only 14 others on that exclusive roll.

"The loyalty Tony and Carol have shown to one club over more than five decades is almost unheard of today," Club President Gregg Duncan said.

### Tony Dickinson – Club Legend

Tony's service stretches across every corner of the Braves and beyond. Since the mid-1970s, he has been President, Treasurer, Secretary, Vice President, Coach, scorer, fundraiser, and canteen volunteer. He was awarded Life Membership in 1982 yet never stopped giving back.

At league level, Tony's impact has been just as significant. A Life Member of the Latrobe Valley Baseball Association, he has played a central role in shaping baseball across the region for more than 50 years.

### Carol Dickinson – Life Member

Carol's recognition came as a surprise on the night, but few in the room were shocked by the decision. Since moving to Churchill in 1974, Carol has been the club's heartbeat — hand-sewing the first uniforms from pyjama patterns, running the canteen from the boot of a car, scoring, fundraising, and always stepping in when help was needed.

Even today, Carol remains a constant presence — helping in the canteen, encouraging players, and being the welcoming face for new families.

"Between them, they've done almost everything a baseball club could ask for," President Gregg Duncan added. "Their fingerprints are on every part of our history, and their loyalty has been unshakable."
