Victorian Government to Support Australian Youth Championships for Next Three Years

The Victorian Government has thrown its support behind Australia's premier youth baseball tournament, securing the Australian Youth Championships (AYC) in Melbourne for the next three years.

The AYC features two marquee national titles – the Under 16 and Under 18 divisions – and serves as the nation's leading Performance Pathways event, where emerging baseball talent showcase their skills in front of more than 15 Major League Baseball scouts and college recruiters each year.

From 2026 through 2028, fourteen teams across both divisions will compete at a tournament in Melbourne, continuing the city's legacy as one of the greatest sporting capitals in the world. This January, the tournament will be held at Essendon, Preston and Port Melbourne Baseball Clubs.

Club News: Inclusion Consultation Survey


Creating safe, inclusive and welcoming spaces is a high priority for Baseball Victoria, and as part of this work, we have partnered with not-for-profit organisation 'Proud2Play' (P2P), a leader in the LGBTQIA+ sports/active recreation space.

We are currently participating in the P2P Rainbow Roadmap program, designed to support sporting organisations to create authentic culture change around inclusion. This process includes assessment of all relevant policies, assets and activities (online and on-site) related to LGBTQIA+ and inclusion more broadly where possible.

The next step in this journey is to consult with our members to understand their unique perspectives on what we do well in this space, and where there is room for improvement. We are looking for honest experiences of our administration and clubs.

If you have children at your club, whether it be for junior competitions or family events, please keep in mind the updated Working with Children Check and Child Protection/Sports Integrity guidelines.

All club volunteers, including committee members, coaches, umpires, scorers, groundskeepers, and canteen staff, must have a valid WWCC with a list regularly maintained by the club. We ask that all club committee members also complete the <u>11 Child Safe Sport Modules</u>.
