Club News: Baseball Australia Call for AYC Ground Announcers

In 2026, Baseball Australia is focused on further elevating the standard and experience of national events. With three outstanding diamonds in Melbourne hosting the Australian Youth Championships (AYC), Baseball Australia will be publishing daily news articles and livestreaming more than 50% of all games with commentary.

All games at Port Melbourne and 24 of the 28 games at Essendon will be broadcast with full commentary. To complement this coverage and enhance the on-site experience, Baseball Australia would also like to introduce ground announcing at Preston games to help lift the atmosphere and engagement for players, families, and spectators. They are seeking the support of our community to help fulfil this position and contribute to making the 2026 AYC a high-quality and memorable event for all involved.

Baseball Australia will provide all required equipment, a prime shaded viewing position, a per diem, and a simple script. Please note that ground announcing is not commentary. The role involves announcing batters as they come to the plate and playing music between innings from a Baseball Australia Spotify playlist. Announcers must remain neutral and should not call plays, cheer, or show bias.

All club volunteers, including committee members, coaches, umpires, scorers, groundskeepers, and canteen staff, must have a valid WWCC with a list regularly maintained by the club. We ask that all club committee members also complete the [11 Child Safe Sport Modules](#).
