The U16s went 2-0 on their first day while the U18s will open their campaign on Friday. There are also 11 Victorians on the combined [ACT Roos](#) rosters (six U16 and five U18), offering talented athletes who narrowly miss out on their home state squads the chance to gain meaningful national-level experience.

BV Performance Pathway Futures Plus Tryouts

Baseball Victoria is proud to offer a new advanced skills program focusing on smaller team group sessions with a tournament to conclude on the weekend of Saturday 28 and Sunday 29 March 2026.

BV Performance Pathway Futures Plus tryouts will be conducted at Melbourne Ballpark from 19-21 January. Players will be required to attend at least one of these sessions.

Once selected, training will be conducted in the East and West of Melbourne (exact time and locations TBC), with players to nominate their preferential location (please note, this may not be facilitated depending on position and squad balance).
