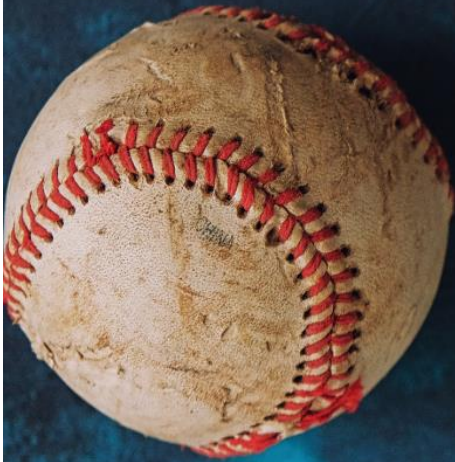

Trials will be hosted during July, with the final team to be selected at the end of July.

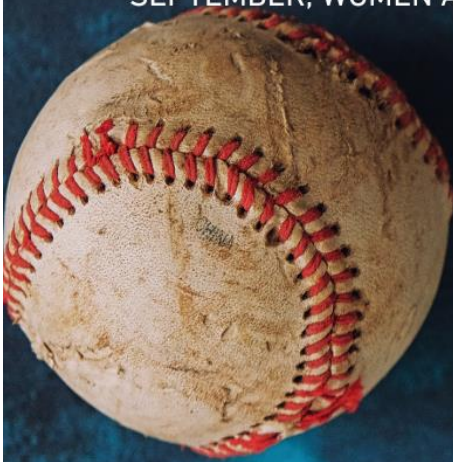

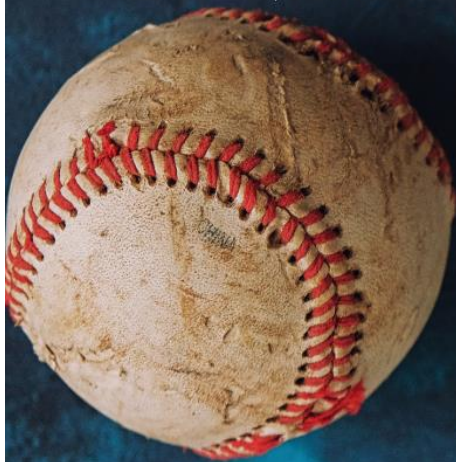

All interest for this working group must be submitted by 26 June.

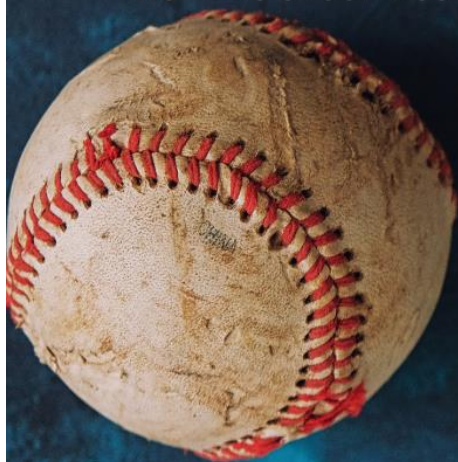
